Frank Stella's *The Broken Jug. A Comedy [D#3] (left handed version)*, 2007

American icon Frank Stella returns to LA with his first solo show in the city since 1995, exhibiting a range of recent works at Sprüth Magers that capture the artist's decades-long exploration of spatial representation. Stella debuts a previously unseen series of new paintings, playing with the multi-dimensional potential of a two-dimensional medium. Space comes to life with the massive wooden sculpture at the center of the gallery, *The Broken Jug.
